



FOODWALL OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

Watering

- Water all tubs via the single hose connection located on the water level box.
- Change the water level to suit different plants and seasons.
 - **SOAK** let your seedlings establish (in summer).
 - **MAX** is recommended for mature plants in hot weather.
 - And winter seedling establishment.
 - **MID** is will ensure a dry crust is maintained for surface aeration.
 - **MIN** allows you to drain the water reservoir.
- Fill the water level box slowly until water begins to drain out of the bottom water level box.
 - Divert this overflow water to the drain, or manually recapture it and add into the top water level box.
- Foodwall should only need watering 1 - 2 times a fortnight. There is enough stored water at the SOAK level for it to last two weeks without watering.
- Top watering is only required immediately after seedlings are planted or when applying an organic fertiliser.

Fertiliser

- Use an environmentally friendly natural product such as Seasol.
- Add to the top of the Foodwall following the dilution, quantity and frequency specified by the product. Water in with a hose or water can.

Potting Mix

- Only use a good quality wicking garden bed potting mix.
- Turnover and aerate your potting mix within each tub with every new crop (approximately every 6 weeks).
- Replace your potting mix every 12 months or rotate potting mix regularly using a composting heap or worm farm.
